Staff at St John's Lutheran Primary School support the mission and ministry of the school and Lutheran Church of Australia, and as such, are expected to have an active Christian faith and be able to demonstrate a high degree of competency and skill in teaching in a 21st Century classroom environment.

Expressions of Interest are open for the following teaching and leadership positions:

- **Primary Classroom Teachers (12 Month Contract)**
- **Casual Relief Teachers**
- **Director of Pastoral Care and Wellbeing (3 Year Contract)** *The DoPCW is a Position of Added Responsibility (PAR) and has a teaching load of 0.4 FTE (to be negotiated with the Principal).*

Successful applicants must be available to commence from **Monday 17 January 2022 for Induction and Professional Learning.**

Key Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated qualifications in education/leadership and commitment to and support of Christian Education;
2. Demonstrated specific expertise and teaching/leadership experience in the Primary years of schooling;
3. Demonstrated skills in and understanding of the development and implementation of units of work; including the use of documented planning and assessment procedures to ensure high standards of learning occur;
4. Demonstrated understanding of restorative practices and building positive student behaviours;
5. Demonstrated ability to relate to the school community in a positive, respectful and supportive manner, maintaining confidentiality and upholding the values of the school;
6. An understanding of the individual needs of students and demonstrated skills in meeting these in the context of the classroom and in pastoral care.

Interested applicants are required to submit a brief resume; contact details for three (3) referees (of which one must be from clergy) and a maximum two-page written response outlining the key selection criteria. Applicants should also include copies of their qualifications, including proof of current Queensland College of Teachers registration.
