OUTSIDE SCHOOL HOURS CARE


Parents enjoy peace of mind with our Outside School Hours Care program which operates Monday-Friday after school and during holidays.

Prep is an exciting place full of stories, play zones, toys and games - and many things to discover and learn about.

However, starting school for the first time can often be daunting for students and parents. It is a time where routines, good communication and much handholding can ensure a successful transition from pre-Prep to school life.

Our job at St John's is to ensure our youngest learners feel safe and secure in an environment of high care. Our priority is to nurture our students in their learning and personal development so that they can start to fulfil their potential from the outset.

The fundamentals of literacy and numeracy are our core learning focus in the early years. This is balanced through a broad offering of indoor and outdoor play as well as a variety of activities and specialist lessons.

ENROLMENT PREPARATION - PREP READINESS

St John's understands the importance of helping each family prepare for Prep attendance. We provide additional enrolment information specific for Day 1 readiness, as well as information regarding school expectations and attendance guidelines. To help their transition be as smooth and welcoming as possible, each child enrolled for Prep will be invited to attend Prep Readiness sessions in the lead up to commencement.

Where talents IGNITE

THE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT AT ST JOHN'S IS DYNAMIC AND CHALLENGING.

Based on the Australian Curriculum and an Inquiry-Based Learning philosophy, we strive to prepare students for secondary school through a showcase of exciting programs. Each student is nurtured and individually known by the whole school community and given every opportunity to develop their talents.

LEARNING ENRICHMENT

At St John's it is acknowledged that some students have identified gifts and talents in one or more areas of development. Learning and Teaching staff provide a variety of teaching strategies to meet the needs of gifted and talented students. Learning extension is offered if it is deemed appropriate. Our goal is to work with parents and students for the best educational outcomes for all students who have an identified gift and or talent.

STEM, CHESS AND LEGO

Students are able to expand their understanding of Science and Technology as all classes conduct a range of robotics programs - from the basics of inputs and outputs to understanding and programming code. St John's students also participate in Science Week, with the students taking on the role of experts and hosting sessions for their peers. Visiting experts from educational experiences such as World of Maths and The Surfing Scientist ensure St John's students have wonderful opportunities in STEM. Regular Chess and Lego Club is also available in the library.

SPORT

Apart from athletics, cross country and swimming carnivals, students have access to numerous sports including but not limited to, touch football, soccer, netball, gymnastics and 'learn-to-swim'.

CAMPS AND EXCURSIONS

All students particpate in excursions and students undertake outdoor education in camps at various year levels.

MUSIC AND PERFORMING ARTS

Students can learn an instrument or participate in ensembles, bands and choirs. Every year the school showcases the talents of our musicians at our Twilight Concert. Generally every second year our school engages in a whole school Musical with every student participating in the elements of the production.

ACADEMIC COMPETITIONS


Students at St John's participate in numerous national and state competitions in mathematics, writing, spelling, reading and more. We rank highly at regional and state levels and have been State Gold Medallists in the Readers' Cup Challenge.

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS

St John's is connected to the Great Barrier Reef's "Reef Guardian" schools program and has an active Eco Club which fosters a sense of stewardship for God's creations: the earth, its environs and natural resources. Eco Leaders are given responsibility to raise awareness, assist in garden design/development and implement initiatives like minimising the school's footprint, related to waste management.

Pastoral Care at St John's is embedded in the way our students, staff and community foster and show care for one another.
